

# **Emergency Remote Teaching & Distance Education**

Despite the quick adaptation of teachers and students to overcome the limitations of consecutive confinements, studies show that students recognize taht as the unique possibility of compensating restrictions during the pandemic AND also show that students would prefer face-to-face education in the future

Many papers were written **but it is still difficult to grasp clearly** the effects of "emergency remote teaching" in different areas, worldwide

### **Emergency Remote Teaching & Distance Education**

The online experimentation resources, e.g., during these periods were VERY useful BUT suffered the effects of **lack of maintenance**. In general, only simulations and augmented reality applications did higher immunity to that effect;

For any kind of online content, the **instructional design is fundamental**. Again, the teaching development is vital to face these competences;

**Finally,** once free of pandemic condition, the teaching methodologies have to be according the HE regulations.
